'CANDLEMAS'

When Mary and Joseph presented their son to God, Simeon and Anna, representing all faithful Jews, recognized him as both Israel's Saviour and the one who would 'enlighten the Gentiles'. This festival may be celebrated by processing with lighted candles, symbolizing Christ, the True Light. Held on or near 2nd February, it closes the Epiphany season, but the sombre words of Simeon hint at sufferings to come.

PENITENCE

THE GOSPEL

Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Luke *Glory to you, O Lord.*

(After the reading)
This is the Gospel of the Lord. **Praise to you, O Christ.**

Today the Lord is presented in the Temple in substance of our mortal nature. *Alleluia!* Today the Blessed Virgin comes to be purified in accordance with the law. *Alleluia!* Today old Simeon proclaims Christ as the light of the nations and the glory of Israel.
